I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on April 06, 2021, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Iowans for a Progressive Tomorrow, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102, 30103, 30104 by failing to organize, register, and report as a political committee.
 - b. Find reason to believe that Iowans for a Progressive Tomorrow, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(4)(B)(iii), (g)(1) by failing to properly report its independent expenditures.
 - c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated May 30, 2019.
 - d. Authorize the use of compulsory process.
 - e. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented. Commissioner Walther abstained.

2. Decided by a vote of 5-1 to:

Refer the MUR to the Office of Alternative Dispute Resolution.
