The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 21L-23 for processing on April 30, 2021, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1018. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred TAKEACTION MN FEDERAL FUND and Elianne Farhat, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$150,000 to support one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2020 12-Day Pre-General Report. On January 29, 2021, the Committee filed a 48-Hour Report including this independent expenditure.

On January 29, 2021, the Committee also filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) acknowledging that it did not file the 48-Hour Report in a timely manner. Further, the Committee noted that it was carefully tracking expenditures requiring 24-Hour Reports, but it missed the requirement to file 48-Hour Reports.
