The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 21L-46 for processing on July 26, 2021, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1039. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred GARRET GRAVES FOR CONGRESS and Christel Slaughter, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to remedy excessive and impermissible 2020 Primary and General contributions totaling \$35,800 within the permissible timeframe. Of this amount, the Committee refunded \$35,000 outside of the permissible timeframe, and \$800 remains unremedied.

The Committee filed Form 99s (Miscellaneous Electronic Submissions) on February 24, 2020; November 5, 2020; January 19, 2021; and February 17, 2021 detailing the Committee's efforts to remedy the excessive and impermissible contributions. In addition, the Committee noted that it has safeguards in place to ensure that contributions are made by eligible contributors with federally permissible funds.
