Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 1057 (RAD 21L-64). The ADR Office received this referral on November 4, 2021.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Hickenlooper for Colorado and Mark Turnage, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely refund or redesignate contributions in excess of the limit totaling \$24,500 and receiving a prohibited contribution totaling \$1,500 during the 2019-2020 election cycle. All contributions have been refunded outside of the permissible timeframe.

The Committee filed Form 99s (Miscellaneous Electronic Submissions) on April 23, 2020, and July 7, 2020, detailing its efforts to remedy the excessive and prohibited contributions. In addition, the Committee disclosed refunds on its amended 2020 April Quarterly Report, as well as its original 2020 12 Day Pre-

Primary Report. During negotiations, the Committee noted that the contributions at issue represent 0.001% of the total number of contributions the campaign received during the 2019-2020 election cycle and were refunded before the 2020 General election.
