Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 1085 (AD A19-21). The ADR Office received this referral from the Audit Division on August 16, 2022.

SUMMARY: The Audit Division referred Association for Emergency Responders and Firefighters, PAC and Robert Piaro, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for one (1) finding detailed in the Final Audit Report of the Commission, as approved on July 28, 2022. The Commission approved a finding that the Committee understated its disbursements by \$769,804 on the original reports filed over the two-year period ending December 31, 2018.

In response to the audit, the Committee stated that it continues to refine its processes and procedures, including improving communication and document sharing with
