Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Forward Progress and Jessie Hunt, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$193,000 to support one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2022 12-Day Pre-Primary Report. On June 22, 2022, the Committee filed one (1) 48-Hour Report to Support this independent expenditure.

In a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) filed on September 6, 2022, the Committee states that the 48-Hour Report was not timely filed due to a miscommunication about the type of activity and therefore the Committee was unaware of a need to file a 48-Hour Report.
