RESOLUTION TERMS: Certify that a representative of the Committee participated  
in an FEC training and pay a civil penalty of \$3,200.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 1093 (RAD 22L-24). The ADR Office received this referral from the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) on November 22, 2022.

**SUMMARY:** RAD referred Davis for Congress/Friends of Davis and Vera G. Davis, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2022 12-Day Pre-Primary Report filed on June 21, 2022. After discovering the error, the Committee filed a series of amendments to correct the public record. Most recently, on January 26, 2023, the Committee filed an Amended 12-Day Pre-Primary Report which disclosed \$59,132 in additional disbursements.

During negotiations, the Committee stated an incomplete version of its 2022 12-Day Pre-Primary Report was inadvertently filed. The Committee further states it

identified the cause of the issue and will review uploaded reports prior to filing to ensure this error does not reoccur.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. Approve the attached Negotiated Settlement of Davis for Congress/Friends of Davis and Vera G. Davis, Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
