The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 23L-02 for processing on February 7, 2023, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1096. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred McConnell Senate Committee and Larry J. Steinberg, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for the receipt of excessive contributions totaling \$108,577.48 designated for the 2020 Primary and General Elections.

The Committee remedied contributions totaling \$99,982.48 outside of the permissible timeframe. At this time, 2020 Primary and General Election contributions totaling \$8,595.00 remain unremedied. On March 23, 2022, the Committee filed an FEC Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) clarifying excessive contributions received during the 2020 election cycle.
