The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 23L-54 for processing on September 26, 2023, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1142. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Jon Ossoff for Senate and Steven Mele, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to remedy excessive and prohibited 2020 General and Runoff Election contributions totaling \$363,272.43 within the permissible timeframe. All of these excessive and prohibited 2020 General and Runoff Election contributions have been remedied outside of the permissible timeframe.

On April 12, 2021, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating it had either refunded, redesignated, or reattributed the excessive and prohibited contributions. Further, the Committee detailed its internal policies for identifying and remedying contributions related to foreign nationals, unregistered organizations, and contributions received from LLCs. On July 5, 2023, the Committee filed a Form 99 listing additional refunds.
