The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 23L-69 for processing on December 12, 2023, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1155. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: RAD referred People's Action Power and Marta Popadiak, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2021 Mid-Year Report and 2021 Year-End Report. On July 31, 2023, the Committee filed an Amended 2021 Mid-Year Report and an Amended 2021 Year-End Report which disclosed additional disbursements totaling \$106,608.43 and \$152,833.15, respectively.

On October 15, 2023, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that during the course of an internal review of its FEC reports, the Committee discovered that certain disbursements were not disclosed. The Committee retained a compliance firm to prepare and file the amended reports. The Committee also notes that none of the disbursements were independent expenditures or contributions to other federal committees.
