The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 24L-04 for processing on January 23, 2024, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1157. The Office of General Counsel transferred MUR 8121 for processing on January 23, 2024, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 1158. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Jayme Stevenson for Congress and William G. Parrett, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) failed to disclose all financial activity on its 2022 30-Day Post-General Report. On April 14, 2023, the Committee filed an Amended 2022 30-Day Post-General Report which disclosed additional disbursements totaling \$157,511.70 which were not disclosed in the original report.

On March 14, 2023, Sarah Locke filed a Complaint alleging that Respondents filed a falsely disclosed 2022 30-Day Post-General Report, including deliberately reporting inaccurate contribution figures that do not reflect campaign fundraising, as well as inaccurate expenditure activity.
