ADR 1097 (Pre-MUR 630, RR 20L-04, and AR 19-01R) – Steve Chabot

DATE: June 15, 2023

On January 26, 2023, the Commission voted to transfer Pre-MUR 630, RR 20L-04, and AR 19-01R to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office (ADRO), and the ADRO designated the matter ADR 1097.

On February 22, 2023, Respondents agreed to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) process and toll the statute of limitations.¹ On June 15, 2023, after a series of discussions, the Committee's participation in ADR process terminated as the result of an impasse.

In accordance with ADRO's procedure to transfer matters in which an agreement could not be reached to the Office of General Counsel, this matter is transferred to your office, effective immediately.

ADRO records will now reflect ADR 1097 (Pre-MUR 630, RR 20L-04, and AR 19-01R) as closed.

¹ The Committee agreed to toll of the statute of limitations for a total of 113 days while participating in the ADR process between February 22, 2023, and June 15, 2023.
