
RESOLUTION TERMS: Pay a \$5,475 civil penalty and work with Commission staff
to terminate political committee status and reporting
obligations.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 1183 (RAD 24L-31). The ADR Office received this referral from the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) on September 19, 2024.

SUMMARY: RAD referred Neighbors for Samuels and Andrew Minck, Treasurer, (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to remedy excessive 2022 primary election contributions, totaling \$13,800, and for failing to remedy contributions designated for the 2022 general election, totaling \$59,220, within the permissible timeframes. The Committee refunded all of these contributions, albeit untimely.

During negotiations, the Committee stated the errors were the result of changes in Committee staff within two weeks of the primary election. The Committee stated it has since remedied the contributions, albeit untimely, and put measures in place

to prevent similar issues from occurring in the future. The Committee further stated it intends to terminate its political committee status upon resolution of this matter.



RECOMMENDATIONS:
