penalty of \$500.

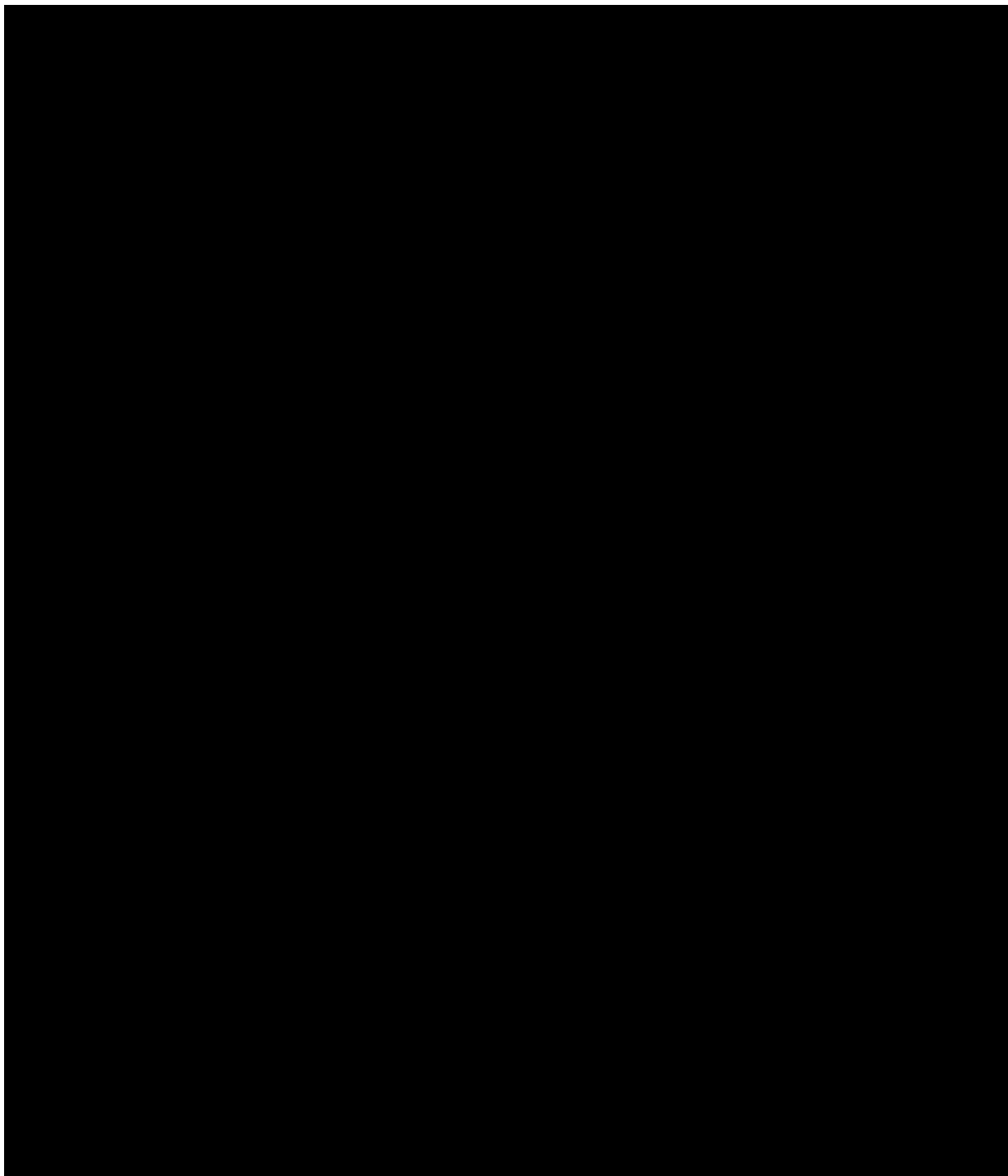
Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 1198 (RAD 23L-61). The ADR Office received this referral from the the Office of General Counsel (OGC) on January 14, 2025, in accordance with a Commission vote.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Brittany for the People and Mark Hanna, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2022 October Quarterly Report, filed on October 17, 2022. On April 14, 2023, the Committee filed an Amended 2022 October Quarterly Report which disclosed \$115,888.10 in additional disbursements.

In response to the RAD referral, Respondents stated that the increase in disbursements was unintentional and due to a technical error with the Committee's filing software. Specifically, Respondents state that the disbursements were originally recorded with an incorrect calendar year and not linked to the appropriate

reporting period. During negotiations, the Committee additionally noted that it intends to terminate its political committee status upon resolution of this matter.
