Attached for your review is a signed agreement for ADR 149 (RR 03L-03) - Respondents Friends of David Worley and Gregg Brasher, Treasurer. This case originated with a referral from RAD on December 8, 2004 and was assigned to the ADR Office on January 6, 2004.

ADR 149/RR 03L-03: The RAD referral states that Respondents received excessive contributions from individuals and non-party multi-candidate political committees that were not refunded, redesignated or reattributed timely. Contributions totaling \$55,300 were designated for the 2002 Run-Off Election or the 2002 General Election, which the candidate did not participate in. Respondents refunded \$11,500 of the contributions, and are in the process of refunding the balance of \$100,950. Respondents submitted the check for the civil penalty with the executed agreement.

Recommendation: We recommend that the Commission approve the negotiated settlement for ADR 149, and that we subsequently close the file on this matter and send the appropriate letters.
