Attached for your review is a signed agreement for ADR 151 (RAD 03-02) - respondents United Food & Commercial Workers, Active Ballot Club and Anthony Perrone, Treasurer. This case originated with a referral from RAD on December 27, 2003, and was assigned to the ADR Office on January 26, 2004.

ADR 151 (RAD 03-02): Respondents failed to file 24 Hour Notices for five (5) independent expenditures made prior to the 2002 General Election totaling \$70,000. Respondents stated that the failure to file 24-Hour Notices on the independent expenditures to Buying Time, Inc., a vendor, was an oversight.

Recommendation: We recommend that the Commission approve the negotiated settlement for ADR 151, that we subsequently close the file on this matter and send the appropriate letters.
