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To Whom It May Concern:

Please consider this letter and accompanying documents as an official complaint alleging willful violations of Federal Election Campaigns Laws and/or Federal Election Commission regulations by Congressman John Sullivan, Sullivan for Congress Campaign Treasurer Gregory T. Colpitts, and the John Sullivan for Congress Campaign.

Specifically, I allege that John Sullivan and Gregory T. Colpitts knowingly and intentionally filed false FEC reports indicating no debt was owed to Pearson Communication Group, (PCG) a US corporation, and others, at the conclusion of Sullivan's special primary election, for the purpose of misleading and defrauding the FEC, the public and the media on the financial status of his campaign. Additionally, I allege that Pearson Communication Group, Inc. took extraordinary steps to inform John Sullivan and Gregory T. Colpitts of the actual amounts owed, strongly advised against filing false reports and even provided additional documents and written advice that the amounts being reported were false and amended reports should be filed.

Item 1 – Pearson Communication Group, Inc. had a written contract (Exhibit A) providing certain compensation for consulting services, among which was a \$25,000 “win bonus” at which time John Sullivan became the Republican nominee for Congress. Yet in the “Pre-General Election Report,” filed on 12/27/2001 (Exhibit B) the Campaign lists debt as “0.” Sullivan and Colpitts were aware of a contract, in force since the prior April, that the \$25,000 win bonus was due upon his becoming the GOP nominee. Actual debt to just PCG as of 12/31/2001 was \$51,469.73. This debt was known and invoiced to John Sullivan and Gregory T. Colpitts and their refusal to report it was an attempt to manipulate the media and the public in expectation of the coming general election.

Item 2 – I personally notified John Sullivan and Gregory T. Colpitts of the false reporting and suggested they file an amendment. False “Post General” election amendments were filed (Exhibits C & D) on 2/6/2002 and on 2/12/2002. Again the reports listed “0” debt. Actual debt to PCG at the time was about \$47,761.27 and the Campaign had paid \$14,004.13 since the prior report, which had also not been reported.

Item 3 – I again personally notified John Sullivan and Gregory T. Colpitts of the false reporting. On 4/9/2002 another “Post Election” amendment (Exhibit E) was filed, this time listing total debt a \$69,792.33. Actual debt to PCG at that time was \$51,765.40. The campaign did not provide a detailed listing of outstanding debt, so it is impossible to say if PCG debt was accurately reported. However, I have personal knowledge that other debts existed which, when combined with PCG debt, exceeded the amount reported by the campaign.

Item 4 – On 4/11/2002, John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts filed the April Quarterly report (Exhibit F) and again listed “0” for debt. Yet, that same report does NOT list disbursements equaling the amount of debt reported on the 3rd “Post Election” amendment. It is important to note that this quarterly report covers a time frame from 1/29 through 3/31/2002. As of 3/31/2002, debt owed to PCG was approximately \$47,000. During this timeframe, the campaign paid PCG a total of \$5670.26. It is difficult to determine what this payment was for since they did not pay according to invoice, but suffice it to say it was mostly for debt, which they did not report.

Item 5 – On 4/26/02, the campaign filed yet another amendment, this time amending the April quarterly report, and this time reporting \$110,535 in debt. Again there was no itemization of debt, so it impossible to determine how much of that debt was owed to PCG.

Item 6 – On 6/20/02, yet another amendment was filed to the April Quarterly report (Exhibit H), this time listing the debt at \$120,837.57. This time the campaign provided a Schedule D which listed debts to PCG at \$50,261.27. Again, the actual debt to PCG at the close of this filing period was approximately \$47,000. This debt was known and invoiced to John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts prior to the filing period and should have been shown on the original April quarterly filing. It was not reported, I allege, because John Sullivan did not want to show debts as he was engaged in another election and did not want the press and public to know he had substantial debt. The amendments came only after he began to refuse to honor his contractual obligation and pay his debts and I told him I intended to file an FEC complaint if he did not correct the false reports. John Sullivan himself acknowledged that he owed PCG and promised to pay, but said it was important not to show debt on the FEC reports at this point in time. I persisted and he and Gregory Colpitts began filing the amendments.

Item 7 – Also on 6/20/02, John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts filed another amendment to the “Post General” election report, (Exhibit I) again reporting \$125,809.37 in debt. The “Post General” report covers the time period 12/20 through 01/28/02. As noted in Item 2, actual debt to PCG at the time was about \$47,761.27, but Schedule D reports debts to PCG on \$55,265.88. Again, I allege John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts falsely reported no debt in the original report so as to deceive the FEC, the public and the media.

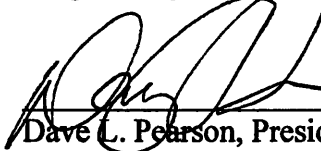
Item 8 – On 9/13/02, John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts filed a fourth amendment to the “April Quarterly,” (Exhibit J) now listing debts in the amount of \$118,989.72, with \$47,640.78 of that amount attributed to PCG. This amount appears to be relatively accurate, the first

accurate report filed, and importantly, it was filed after the Sullivan campaign successfully avoided a primary by falsely reporting no debt, which inflated his campaign's financial status.

Item 9 – Finally, on 12/16/02, I authored a letter (Exhibit K) notifying John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts that they had been falsely reporting to the FEC and virtually every report filed had false and inaccurate debt figures attributed to PCG and others. I provided a detailed statement (Exhibit L) reflecting invoice dates and payments. Yet to this day, the most recent report (Exhibit M) filed inaccurately and falsely reports debt to PCG of \$12,277.64 when the actual debt is \$15,042.58. I allege and charge that John Sullivan and Gregory Colpitts knowingly and willingly conspired to file false FEC reports in an effort to deceive the FEC, the media and the public in order to enhance his re-election campaign's financial status.

Item 10 – I also allege that Sullivan and Culprits knowingly and intentionally failed to report other actual debt on the 12/27/01 "Pre-General" election, which debt is eventually filed in subsequent amended reports. I charge that Sullivan and Culprits intentionally filed a false report so as to deceive the FEC, the public and the media as to the financial condition of his campaign. The names of the debtors are included in the subsequent amendments. Some, but not all of those debts have been satisfied.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

This document is a legally binding contract between John Sullivan, a natural person, and candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, hereafter referred to as the "Client" and Pearson Communication Group, Inc., a political consulting company, hereafter referred to as PCG. This written contract formalizes a verbal contract entered into by the Client and PCG in April of 2001.

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COUNSEL

2001 JUN -9 PM 8:06

The terms of the contract are as follows. The Client wishes to retain the consulting services of PCG to assist him in his campaign and election to Congress in exchange for valuable consideration. PCG agrees to provide certain consulting services in exchange for valuable consideration.


Valuable consideration is (A) a monthly retainer fee, beginning on April 1, in the amount of \$2500 per month until such time as a formal election date is determined, at which time the monthly retainer amount will increase to \$3000 per month. (B) A \$25,000 "win bonus" as such time as Client becomes the Republican Nominee for Congress. (C) A 15% commission on the actual cost of production of all media or mail products associated with the campaign and a 15% commission on the placement of all media and mail products associated with the campaign. The monthly retainer is due and payable in advance on the first of each month. Commission payments are due and payable at the time of media or mail production and placement. The \$25,000 "win bonus" is due and payable within 60 days of the Client becoming the Republican nominee for Congress.

The Client agrees that he is personally responsible and liable for all costs incurred by PCG on behalf of the Client and valuable consideration due and owed to PCG, regardless of the financial status of the Client's campaign. The Client acknowledges that he has failed to pay PCG the monthly retainer fee for September, October and November and that as of the date of this agreement he owes PCG \$8,000 in past due monthly retainer fees.

TERMINATION - Either party may terminate this agreement with a written notice. PCG will be due all outstanding valuable consideration, including the full monthly retainer for the month in which the termination takes place. All retainer fees and costs associated with media and/or mail production plus the 15% commission up to the time of termination is due and payable by the Client immediately. Should PCG be terminated by the Client prior to a Republican nominee being elected, PCG will be awarded 1/2 of the "win bonus" as consideration for PCG's services that preceded the election. This is due and payable within 60 days of the time of termination.

The Client and PCG willingly enter into this agreement without duress on the 17th day of November 2001.

In reviewing your various reports to the Federal Election Commission, I note that you have incorrectly reported debts owed to Pearson Communication Group, Inc. Your last post election report states a debt owed to "Dave Pearson" in the amount of \$12,277.64. The debt is actually \$14,198.28 and is owed not to "Dave Pearson," but rather to Pearson Communication Group, Inc. As corporation, Pearson Communication Group, Inc. is unable to "forgive" debt as that would constitute an illegal corporate contribution to a federal candidate.

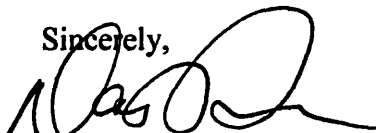
I urge you to file an amended report accurately reporting your debt. By copy of this letter, I am notifying the Federal Election Commission of the outstanding corporate debt owed by the John Sullivan for Congress Committee.

In reviewing our contract, I note that you agreed to pay all debt within 60 days of your becoming the Republican nominee for congress. That election occurred nearly a year ago, yet there is still a substantial debt outstanding. Be aware that interest charges accrue because of your inability or unwillingness to meet your contractual obligations.

Also, in reviewing the various reports filed by your committee, it appears that the debt to Pearson Communication Group, Inc. has been misreported numerous times. I am enclosing statements reflecting debt owed and debt satisfied since the inception of our contractual relationship. I trust this will enable you to correct your records to accurately report debt owed and provide the Federal Election Commission with the information needed to assure accurate and timely reporting.

Please let me know at your earliest convenience your intentions for the remaining debt. Please know that Pearson Communication Group, Inc. will take all actions necessary to assure you fulfill your contractual obligations. Thank you.
