Dear Mr. Jordan:

We received your letter on March 16, 2004. This is intended to be the response of David Brigham for Congress Campaign Committee, the candidate David Brigham, and I as its treasurer. No action should be taken by the Commission pursuant to the complaint for the reasons set forth below.

As to the first paragraph of the complaint, there were no disbursements by the Committee reportable during the period ended February 18, 2004 under the applicable Federal Elections, Code of Federal Regulations. After February 18, 2004, the Committee reimbursed the candidate for expenditures made prior to February 18, 2004. These expenditures were not compiled or knowable with sufficient precision prior to the due date for the filing to be included in the February 18, 2004 report. Such expenditures will be included in the report to be filed as of March 31, 2004.

As to the secondary complaint, there were no contributions reportable under the 48 hour reporting notice at any time during the period February 19, 2004 to the date of the primary election, March 9, 2004.
