

David Brigham for Congress

Attached for your review is a signed agreement for ADR 177 (MUR 5425) - Respondents David Brigham for Congress and Martin Olivares, Treasurer. This case originated with a complaint filed with the Commission on March 8, 2004, and was assigned to the ADR Office on July 1, 2004.

ADR 177/MUR 5425: The complaint alleges that Respondents failed to disclose any campaign disbursements on the Pre-Primary Report, and may have failed to file 48-Hour reporting notices of contributions over \$1,000 received during the period February 19, 2004 through March 6, 2004. Respondents acknowledge that inadvertent violations occurred as to reporting disbursements due to their inexperience, but there were no Primary election contributions to be reported on the 48-Hour notices to the Commission.

ADR Director's Recommendation: We recommend that the Commission approve the negotiated settlement for ADR 177, and that we subsequently close the file on this matter and send the appropriate letters.
