
We have absolutely nothing to do with any political fund raising or charity contribution/fund raising.



Your response, which should be addressed to the General Counsel's Office, must be submitted within 15 days of receipt of this letter. If no response is received within 15 days, the Commission may take further action based on the available information.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B) and § 437g(a)(12)(A) unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the matter to be made public. If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
NOW, INC.

TO: The Recorder of Deeds, D.C.  
Washington, D.C.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Business Corporation Act (D.C. Code, Title 29, Chapter 9), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporations:

**FIRST:** The name of the corporation is NOW, Inc.

**SECOND:** The period of its duration is perpetual.

**THIRD:** The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to act as agents, suppliers and jobbers of office supplies, equipment, furniture, materials, printed products, specialties and services and to perform renovations, repairs and decorator services in office and residential properties in the District of Columbia and elsewhere.


**FOURTH:** The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is 1,000 divided into one class. The designation of each class, the number of shares of each class, and the par value, if any, of the shares of each class or a statement that the shares of any class are without par value, are as follows:




