SUBJECT: Negotiated Settlement ADR 204

Attached for your review is a signed agreement for ADR 204 (AR 04-08) - Respondents Volunteer PAC and Dawn Perkerson, Treasurer. This case originated with a referral from Audit on October 25, 2004, and was assigned to the ADR Office on November 15, 2004.

ADR 204 (AR 04-08): An audit of the 2002 election cycle financial records referred three findings for resolution: 1) that Respondents failed to report earmarked contributions; 2) Respondents over funded federal election activity from a non-federal account due to an incorrect allocation ratio; and 3) Respondents failed to adequately disclose contributions made to federal candidates. Respondents followed the recommendations of the Audit staff following the Interim Audit, and took other steps to ensure they comply with the FECA when filing disclosure reports.

ADR Director's Recommendation: We recommend that the Commission approve the negotiated settlement for ADR 204, and that we subsequently close the file on this matter and send the appropriate letters.
