I received the letter addressed to Drew Walker just last evening regarding MUR5500.

I would like to inform the FEC that there is no validity whatsoever in the above-mentioned MUR.

In the photocopy attached to the complaint your office sent along with the copy of the complaint itself, you will see that in the upper right hand corner of the second photocopied page that the words "Paid for by Walker for Congress, 201 S. Mechanic St., Jackson, MI 49201" are clearly visible. In addition, since this is a reduced photocopy of the larger (enclosed) original brochure mailed to the complainant by our campaign, these words are even more obvious on the original he received. There was only one printing of this brochure, and he received a copy from this one printing.

With this evidence plainly visible, MUR5500 is clearly a false claim that was made by the complainant with very little or no examination of the brochure in question.

Since the evidence for this complaint so clearly shows that it is false, I would like to request that the FEC dismiss this matter as soon as possible.
