
Dear Mr. Silberman:

This letter is in response to your letter dated June 8, 2005.

First, I would like to be enlightened about the complaint you are referring to. What I remember is that (I believe) Robert Anderson Campaign filed a complaint about solicitations. Is that what you are referring to? We thought that was resolved last year. That is the only complaint I was aware of. If it is something else please inform me of the substance.

There has been some on-going references to detail provided on our FEC reports. We file regularly and on-time. When new information comes to light we file amendments. We use a third party software supplier (Grossos). Due to contract negotiations with them support has not been there. We hope to resolve that in the near future and provide whatever information we have available on a more complete basis. We make a good faith effort to supply complete information. At the very least we supply whatever we have. Third party fund raisers sometimes receive donations with incomplete information at least from your view point. These are few and far between.
