In an effort to respond to the complaint dated July 1, 2004 from the Friends of Bob Anderson, the Friends of Greg Parke Committee has conducted an exhaustive investigation into this matter. Bob Anderson first brought this complaint to our attention in May 2004. He has since, as recently as on or about July 2, 2004 called Sharon Parke, the wife of the Candidate, and threatened that no matter what happened he was "going to the FEC". Regardless, since that time we have reviewed all campaign material, specifically in the fundraising area, for how these names could have been used by the Campaign.

The following facts became evident;

The Friends of Greg Parke Committee did in no way, shape or form purchase, borrow or rent any names attributable to the Bob Anderson Committee.

The Friends of Greg Parke direct mail fundraiser did in no way, shape or form purchase, borrow or rent any names attributable to the Bob Anderson Committee.

We have on numerous occasions, since the first time we were contacted by Bob Anderson, asked for and never received copies of the letters in question. It was our intention, and remains so, to insure that no known contributors that donated to Bob Anderson were on any mailing lists used by the Friends of Greg Parke-Committee. Since we did not receive that cooperation, we

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independently had the names researched and purged, if found, from our mailing lists.

As to how exactly this happened, we do not know for sure. However we do know that The Friends of Greg Parke Committee did in no way, shape or form purchase, borrow or rent any names attributable to the Bob Anderson Committee.

This is in reply to your correspondence advising the FEC did not receive our response last year regarding complaint Case Number MUR # 5469.


Attached is the response we sent you by fax and US Mail on 11 Jul 04 regarding this matter. After we sent the letter we received no reply from you and assumed the matter was closed.

In addition, shortly after the incident was brought to our attention, I communicated with Mr. Bob Anderson to resolve it directly. I assured him we did not do this intentionally since it would be illogical to send a thank you to people who were not actual donors to our campaign. It could have no perceived benefit.

We further agreed that I would personally call certain members of his donor list (his father in particular) to explain and apologize for the situation. We further agreed that we would compile a list of his donors and do a compare/purge to ensure removal of said donors from our direct mail list.

This was accomplished apparently to Mr Anderson's satisfaction since we have heard nothing further from him on the matter. Because of these facts we thought the was matter closed.

COMMITMENT TO SUBMIT MATTER TO ADR PROGRAM

ADR/MUR # MUR # 5469

I have read the material describing the Federal Election Commission's (FEC) Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) program and request that my case be considered for it. In the event that my case is accepted and determined to be appropriate for ADR, I agree:

- 1) to engage in the FEC's ADR program as described in the brochure enclosed with the complaint notification letter;
- 2) to participate in, and try to negotiate a settlement of my case and, if unsuccessful to engage in mediation with the aim of achieving a mutually acceptable resolution; and
- 3) to waive the Statute of Limitations provisions governing my case as long as it is being processed in the FEC's ADR program.

I understand that I will be advised by the FEC of its determination regarding my case's appropriateness for ADR and, if selected, given time to prepare for negotiations with a representative of the FEC and to arrange a mutually agreeable time to meet and discuss the case.
