I write to you in reference to the letter sent to our campaign on October 20, 2004, concerning Matter Under Review 5567.

Mr. Thompson's complaint articulates a problem that occurred as the direct result of eighteen well-intentioned individuals coming together to coordinate a campaign event on our behalf. While the candidate was asked to make an appearance at a particular time and place, the invitation was not prepared by the campaign.

A few facts to point out concerning this matter.

- the event, including invitations, was paid for by eighteen individuals, whose in-kind contributions are respectively recorded in our report to the Federal Election Commission, and
- the omission of the "best effort" disclaimer has not impaired our ability to ascertain or report any required information of contributors who give more than \$200 in a calendar year
