SUBJECT: **ADR 255 – Terrell for Senate, et. al.**
Recommendation to Approve the Settlement Agreements and Dismiss Other
Listed Respondents

Attached for your review are a number of signed negotiated ADR settlement agreements pertaining to **ADR 255 (MUR 5656)**, Terrell for Senate (the "Respondents"). The Commission voted on May 6, 2005 to sever forty-two (42) named respondents from MUR 5652, open a new MUR, i.e., 5656, and transfer the named 42 Respondents to the ADR Office.

The following organizations either engaged in the ADR process and signed one of the attached settlement agreements or provided documentation to confirm that they were neither a corporation nor entity covered by the restrictions set forth in 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 114.2. The latter organizations are recommended for dismissal.

Those organizations that entered into the ADR process acknowledged that they had made contributions to the Terrell for Senate campaign committee or to the LA Victory 2002 Fund, which served as a conduit for the Terrell for Senate committee.

The ADR Office is in continuing discussions with the remaining Respondents and will forward settlement agreements pertaining to those parties as they become available. Those Respondents that should be excluded due to their tax status will be listed on attached memorandums simultaneously forwarded to the Commission.

I. ADR Settlement Agreements (the agreements are essentially identical):

- ADR 255-28 – Hollander Properties, LLC – Paid a civil penalty of \$500;
- ADR 255-33 – Sher Garner Cahill Richter Klein & Hilbert, LLC – Paid a civil penalty of \$500.
- ADR 255-42 – Dorignac’s Food Center, LLC – Paid a civil penalty of \$1250.

The allegations against the following organizations are recommended for dismissal given their tax status as either a sole proprietorship, partnership without corporate members or a non-corporate LLC. Each of the aforementioned organizations has provided either tax identification or other appropriate documentation.
