Dear F. E. C.:

On October 18, at approximately 8:45 p.m. PDT, I received a phone call at my home from a female identifying herself as working for the Republican National Committee. She solicited me for an "additional" contribution to the RNC to elect George Bush, as I had "already been generous" with my prior contribution.

I declined, as I have never, ever contributed, nor would I.

I am troubled by this situation, as it appears that *someone else* used my name, address and telephone number to contribute to the RNC for a nefarious reason—probably to hide contributions beyond the legal limit. There is no other legal or obvious reason which would explain this occurrence.

I am requesting that this matter be investigated as soon as possible, as it may mean fraud has been committed by the RNC. My contact information is below. Thank you for your time and attention to this matter.

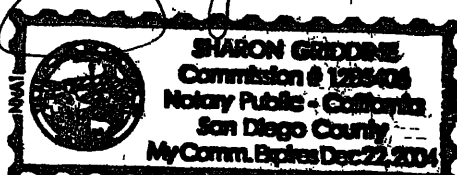
