A letter was sent to the post office box listed for Taff for Congress on July 19, 2005, regarding an opportunity to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") program at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC/Commission") to resolve a complaint filed by Charlyne Rothman. The complaint alleged possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act by Taff for Congress and Kimberly S. Stewart ("Respondents"). The United States Postal Service returned the letter to the Commission with the notation that the postal box was closed and the letter could not be forwarded. Committees are required to maintain valid mailing addresses with the Commission. The original letter is enclosed.

If Respondents are interested in having this referral resolved through ADR, you must affirmatively respond **no later than August 22, 2005** by filing an executed Commitment to Submit Matter to ADR Program and Statement of Designation of Representative/Counsel. These documents are enclosed for your convenience. In the event you submit these documents via facsimile (202-219-0613), please send the originals via first class mail to this Office.

A lack of response will be considered a disinterest in proceeding in ADR and will result in the matter regarding your Committee being forwarded to the FEC's Office of General Counsel.
