SUBJECT: ADR 275 Steven Reifman for Congress and Andrew Glazer, Treasurer  
Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 275 (MUR 5614). This case was opened on June 30, 2005 and was assigned to the ADR Office on July 27, 2005.

**SUMMARY:** The Complainant, CompleteCampaigns.com, alleges that Steven Reifman for Congress and Andrew Glazer, Treasurer ("Respondents" or the "Committee") failed to report a \$450 debt to CompleteCampaigns.com. Complainant also alleges that as Respondents were informed of their obligation to report the debt and failed to do so, that their failure was "willfully fraudulent." Respondents contend that they did not, and do not, believe the amount allegedly owed to CompleteCampaigns.com was a valid debt, and thus did not report it. After receiving the complaint from the Commission, Respondents stated they were modifying their reports with the Commission to include the disputed debt.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached settlement agreement of Steven Reifman for Congress and Andrew Glazer, Treasurer
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
