SUBJECT: ADR 247 and ADR 280 Women's Campaign Fund and Nancy Clack, Treasurer  
Recommendation to approve Settlement Agreement

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated consolidated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 247 (RR 05L-03) and ADR 280 (RR 05L-31), the Women's Campaign Fund and Nancy Clack, Treasurer ("Respondents" or "Committee"). These cases were opened on March 21, 2005 and June 30, 2005 respectively, and were assigned to the ADR Office on May 5, 2005 and July 22, 2005 respectively.

**SUMMARY:** RAD referred Respondents for failing to disclose all receipts as required under the FECA. RAD noted the failure when the Committee filed two amended reports disclosing additional receipts. Respondents filed an amended 2004 April Quarterly Report on July 27, 2004 that disclosed additional receipts totaling \$63,883.22. Respondents also filed an amended 2004 October Quarterly Report on March 10, 2005 that disclosed additional receipts totaling \$51,586.04. Respondents stated that the omissions occurred due to software interface issues and inexperienced staff.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached consolidated settlement agreement of the Women's Campaign Fund and Nancy Clack, Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
