and Rudy Parker, Treasurer,  
Recommendation to Assign Case

On April 26, 2006, the ADR Office received RR 06L-15 to review and determine its appropriateness for ADR processing. Based on that review, we determined that the case is appropriate for ADR, and recommend that it be assigned to the ADR Office.

**SUMMARY:** RAD referred the Democratic Executive Committee of Florida and Rudy Parker, Treasurer, ("Respondents" or the "Committee") for failing to disclose all of the Committee's debt on their 2005 July Monthly Report. Respondents filed their 2005 July Monthly Report on July 20, 2005, disclosing \$76,019.82 in debts and obligations owed by the Committee. An amended 2005 July Monthly Report was filed on November 14, 2005, disclosing \$76,279.09 in debts and obligations owed by the Committee. A second amended 2005 July Monthly Report was filed on November 21, 2005, disclosing \$182,719.10 in debts and obligations owed by the Committee. The additional debts disclosed on the second amendment totaled \$106,699.28. The Committee also filed a miscellaneous electronic submission on November 21, 2006 stating that when reviewing financial activity in response to a RFAI sent for the 2005 August and September Monthly Reports, it discovered that several debts owed by the Committee were omitted from Reports filed for June 1, 2005 through September

30, 2005. These omissions, Respondents contend, were due to administrative oversight.

**Respondents' Reply to RAD:** In response to a RFAI sent to the Committee on December 9, 2005, Respondents stated that the Committee underwent a change in administration, which, in turn, put in place new procedures for all incoming invoices. As a result, not all invoices were released to the compliance department in time to be included in the original report. The Committee further stated that, due to this discovery, the procedures were revised to better accommodate reporting deadlines.
