I am writing to express my concerns with two specific improprieties on the part of the election campaign of Frank J. Gonzalez, Democratic candidate for United States House of Representatives District 21 in Florida. While logged into Mr. Gonzalez's campaign web site, I noticed that he is promoting his personal business openly on it. The information reads as follows, and can be found at <http://www.politicalgateway.com/cand.php?id=186&page=biography> under the subheading "career":

**"Career:**

*Today Frank is a mortgage broker. If you are buying new or refinancing existing residential or commercial property, he hopes you will allow him to present you with a straightforward, no-obligation, no-gimmick proposal by contacting him directly by Email. Given his need to maintain the highest level of integrity in his career just as in his candidacy, he pledges to offer you strong personal attention and a truly competitive loan, regardless of how big or small your needs are."*

Additionally, I am unable to find up-to-date financial information with respect to Mr. Gonzalez's campaign on the Federal Election Commission website. I see that the campaign has already received multiple notices on failure to report, the last one dated 6/30/2005. As of yet, he has failed to file any type of financial report with the FEC since October of 2004. Will Mr. Gonzalez's campaign be sanctioned by the FEC for these infractions that show a disregard for the public trust?
