Re: Irregularities in Gabrielle Giffords for Congress FEC Filings

I am very concerned about honesty and integrity in federal elections. I noticed when I was reviewing the various FEC filings for Gabrielle Giffords, H6AZ08038, that she listed Laura Almquist as her Treasurer in her statement of candidacy that she filed in 2005, and that Almquist signed Giffords' first filings as the treasurer.

In April 2006, however, I see that a Judy Nagle is listed as the treasurer in Giffords' various campaign finance filings. It is my understanding that in order for Nagle to be authorized to sign for Giffords' campaign filings, Giffords must file a notice or letter with the FEC that lists Nagle as the new treasurer, or somehow otherwise makes her the official treasurer. I see nothing of this sort posted to the FEC website. I still see Almquist listed on the FEC website as the treasurer for the Giffords campaign.

I request that this matter as described above be investigated for noncompliance with FEC regulations.


