To whom it may concern,



I do so solemnly swear that the above represents fully and completely the actions I am reporting.

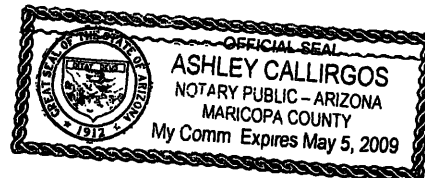
