Dear General Counsel's Office:

Thank you for your letter dated June 6, 2006, informing me of a complaint alleging The Marty Schwimmer Congressional Campaign may have violated the Act. The complaint says, "Mr. Schwimmer was required to file a pre-primary report by Thursday, May 25, 2006, yet the FEC's website reveals that Schwimmer's campaign committee has not filed any report."

Contrary to the complaint, I filed the report in question, and the Commission's website shows the report was filed May 24, 2006. Accordingly, no action should be taken by the Commission against The Marty Schwimmer Congressional Campaign or me, individually and as treasurer, in this matter, and the file should be closed.

Please understand that this complaint was filed only so that its filing could be reported in the local newspaper ("The Desert Sun") shortly before the June 6th election, as a campaign tactic by my opposition. The rhetoric in the complaint - that I was running a "stealth" campaign - mirrors that reported in the paper. The complaint also makes accusations about my former website and newspaper advertisement that are too vague to respond to. No basis for complaint has been stated.
