Dear Ms. Dixon:

I wrote your offices on August 3, 2006, and sent an original, plus 3 copies of a letter and several enclosures, regarding the Tom Hayhurst for Congress Committee.

Your response chastised me for not including the phrase "Subscribed and sworn to before me on". I had not only checked out your website for the requirements for reporting the issue I wrote of, but also the FEC's Campaign Guide and spoke personally to a female in your office by phone. For some reason I'm not surprised that my efforts have come up short.

I went back to the bank where the letter was originally notarized, and provided them with a new letter, dated the same August 3rd, but with a new, original signature. The letter was signed and sworn to in front of Stephanie Muldoon, Wells Fargo Bank Manager, Dupont Branch, Rogelia M. Trevino, AVP in Private Banking, and Claudia Sullivan, the notary whose signature you see on the letter. I trust this is sufficient for your needs.

All the enclosures I originally sent are, I hope, still in your possession. I am enclosing 3 more copies of this letter, as well as 3 additional copies of the original letter, as corrected. I would like this matter dealt with in a civil manner, so shall wait to hear from you. The elections are soon, however, and if necessary I will write a public service letter in the local newspaper, if I must. My name is valuable to me, and I do not like people using it fraudulently, nor should the government, if it truly values democracy.

To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed are several items containing the disclaimer notice "paid for and authorized by the Tom Hayhurst for Congress Committee, Maxine Young, Treasurer and Gerald Young, Assistant Treasurer". Some of these items are dated, and some are not. Those that are not dated were acquired at the Committee's office on 4520 Lima Road, in Fort Wayne, Indiana, 469825, on Wednesday morning, August 2, 2006. Persons who observed me taking the undated items were Rodney "Chip" Scott, field director, and Peter Clerkin, campaign manager.

Also enclosed are copies of resignation letters from both me, as Treasurer, and Gerald Young, as Assistant Treasurer. Please note those resignation letters are dated June 22, 2006, and that the resignations were effective beginning after June 30, 2006.

Tom Hayhurst, M.D. asked each of us to assume those duties early in June of 2005. On FEC Form I, the Statement of Organization, I, as Treasurer, was also listed as Agent on that form.

On a contract between Dr. Hayhurst and Peter Clerkin, signed (I believe) in May, 2006, Peter Clerkin is given "full and complete control of the campaign", and is indicated as "sole agent". I don't have a copy of that contract, anymore. Mr. Clerkin is 25 years old, has no federal election experience and admittedly, has no experience with federal campaign finance. My husband and I are both retired CPAs, and I have had previous experience.

If we are no longer Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, the use of our names is fraudulent. Dr. Hayhurst knows that, and the fact that he needs to replace our names has been discussed, long before we submitted our resignations. He is using our names illegally, and we want him to cease and desist such practice.

Please note the copy of the Hayhurst volunteer newsletter. It was printed from the computer this morning, August 3, 2006, and has both mine and my husband's name illegally designated. Another copy of the website is dated July 31, 2006, and our names again appear illegally.

The donor card is one I picked up from a table at the entrance to the committee's office. It requests contributions to be sent to my address at 8026 Manor Dr. in Fort Wayne. The business card also lists me as Treasurer. Both the donor card and the business card I

picked up, at this office, yesterday morning—Wednesday, August 2, 2006. Prior to entering the office, I took a photo of the door. The door has attached to it, a banner used most often for yard signs. The computer copy of this photo doesn't show this disclaimer very clearly, but I don't think you have to strain your eyes too much to see my name at the bottom, listing me as Treasurer. I'm enclosing my old yard sign so you can see the match. Notice the August 2, 2006 date on the computer copy of the banner. The committee also uses a van, on which is a large banner proclaiming the Hayhurst campaign. My name is also on that banner, but the photo is too small to show it.

We don't wish to get into a big legal hassle, but we are protective of our names, and would appreciate very much if you could make this individual stop using them. The committee's filing ID number is C00413435, and the candidate's ID number is H6IN03161. Thanks so much for your attention.


