I am writing to file an additional complaint on case # MUR 5746. In the July quarterly report for Robinson For Congress I have found many errors. Many are contributions to the primary, well after the primary, which was held on May 2nd, 2006. I understand this is legal if the campaign shows debt from the primary, of which I can not find in their reports. Mr. Robinson shows \$301,514.09 cash on hand with debt owed in the April amended quarterly. I highly doubt that Mr. Robinson's campaign has gone into debt for the primary and seek action on this matter.

These are the errors I have found: (In bold print are the excessive donations)

- 1) July Report- Pg37 and 38 Lawrence DeGeorge- This is not over but, different address and name spelling. They are the same person.
- 2) July- pg 43- Robert J Elchenberg- Gave \$1000 for Primary on May 13th, 11 days after the Primary occurred.
- 3) July- pg 45- Thomas Ewing- Gave \$1000 on day of Primary, also is listed as Thomas and below Tom at same address. Total given does not equal out correctly.
- 4) July- pg 46- Robert Ferguson gave \$1600 for the primary, 6 days after the primary.
Doug Fisher gave \$500 on the day of the Primary for the Primary.
- 5) July- pg47- Vic Flow gave \$1000 for the primary, 21 days after the primary
- 6) July- pg61- Kendre E Horn gave \$1100 for the primary, 1 month and 5 days after the primary occurred.
- 7) July- pg77- **Bob Luddy gave \$2000 for the primary, 11 days after the primary. Mr Luddy also gave \$2100(3/17/06) for the primary on Pg19 of the amended April report.**
- 8) July- pg78- Virginia Manheimer gave \$1100 for the primary, 9 days after the primary.
- 9) July- pg118- Mrs Edgar Uhlain gave \$1100 for the primary on the day of the primary. **Mrs Uhlain is also over the limit giving \$400 on 5/12/06, \$1500 on 6/6/06 and on pg 32 of the amended April report Mrs Uhlain gave \$1000 on 1/19/06 all for the General election and totaling \$2900.**
- 10) July- pg121- **Mr Wayne Washington gave \$2100 for the general election. On the April report on pg 33, Mr Washington also gives \$ 500 and \$100 for the general totaling \$2700.**
- 11) July- pg128- Jacqueline Willoughby gave \$2100 for the primary, 1 month and 26 days after the primary.
- 12) July- pg129- Betty K Wolfe gave \$2100 for the primary, 4 days after the primary.

13) July- pg130- Frank Wood Jr gives \$1600 for the primary, 29 days after the primary. Mr Wood also gives over the limit for the general election, on 5/3 he gives \$500 and on 5/31 he gives another \$2100 putting him \$500 over the limit.

14) July- pg132- Dr Wayne F Yekes MD gives \$2100 for the general on 6/30. Mr Yekes also gives \$1000 on 2/15 in the April report.

It seems highly unlikely that a Treasurer for a Campaign for the US House of Representatives would make that many clerical errors as is suggested in Miscellaneous Report to FEC, dated 6/19/06 It seems like their books are a mess and that there is flagrant disregard for FEC campaign finance laws.

Again, I am requesting a full investigation into this matter with the Robinson for Congress campaign and their treasurer Emily Cummins
