

Dear Mr. Luddy,

The staff and I have looked into the question regarding your 5/17/2006 contribution and discovered that the campaign erred by coding both of your contributions as "primary" on the July Quarterly FEC report. The 5/17 contribution should have been coded as a contribution for the general election.

While looking into this question, we also discovered that the presumptive reattribution of \$200 of your check into your wife's name (permitted by FEC rules) was unsuccessful because the campaign did not send the confirmation letter required by FEC regulations within the prescribed sixty day window. For that reason, we have refunded the said \$200.

An amended FEC report will be filed with the Commission forthwith.

These mistakes were made by the campaign and not by you and we regret any inconvenience this has caused you. Thank you again for your consideration and patience.
