Dear Mrs. Fraser.

As discussed I have attached a copy of the invoice from de Mahy Marketing that reflects the order placed for 250 stickers that read "PAID FOR BY CRAIG ROMERO FOR CONGRESS, INC." Please make note of the timeline which dates the initial complaint letter to the Committee as September 6, 2006, of which I am sure we received that correspondence some three or four days later as delayed by the mail. Upon which our reaction, after some investigation, was to rectify the problem by ordering and placing stickers on those signs that did not bear the disclaimer. This is proofed by the invoice attached dated September 15, 2006. Our official response to this complaint was found in a correspondence to the FEC dated September 12, 2006 and received by your office on September 18, 2006.

To again summarize the situation as I appreciated it at that time; these particular yard signs were printed during the previous election cycle, and were not the subject of a complaint during that cycle. It is my understanding that at the time the printer did not understand the need for adding the disclaimer on the sign. A lack of the disclaimer did not cause any confusion in the minds of the public as to the sponsorship of the message, since these signs read: "Craig Romero for Congress" Once the Committee received the stickers, staff was dispersed to find any of the identified signs and the stickers were placed on those signs not having the disclaimer on them.

Per your instructions, I have requested a correspondence from our general consultant, to assure you that all campaign paraphernalia ordered by them for the 06 campaign.

contained the proper disclaimer. Again, this violation is de minimus at best and should not be the subject of any enforcement action, since the campaign at the time took the necessary steps to correct the problem in an expeditious manner.

In conclusion I would like to add that this Committee is in the process of termination and no positive balance remains in the checking account.

I certainly look forward to bringing this matter to a close and to the termination of this Committee. Should you need any additional information or have any additional questions please do not hesitate to contact me by email or phone.
