

Dear Mr. Jordan:

This letter is in regards to the complaint your office received concerning the existence of lawn signs and campaign literature with improper disclaimers that were being used by the Spencer for Congress campaign (C00422063). On behalf of the Spencer for Congress campaign, I wish to apologize for this error. Until fairly recently, our campaign has been operating solely with volunteers and we have had no professional staff to routinely oversee campaign activities.

However, we now have several paid professional staff who have taken charge of such things as the production of campaign literature. We have also, to the best of my knowledge, removed the yard signs and campaign literature that do not meet FEC requirements and produced new materials that do. I hope that these actions will meet with your approval and that no further action will be necessary in this matter.

Again, on behalf of Spencer for Congress, my apologies for our failure to meet FEC requirements in this regard.
