Summary and Analysis of Case: Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all receipts, disbursements, and debts pursuant to the FECA. In this case, the Respondents filed an amended 2005 Year-end Report on October 12, 2006, disclosing additional receipts totaling \$83,571.85, additional disbursements totaling \$75,764.62, and additional debts totaling \$98,715.26. In an electronic submission responding to a RFAI, the Committee contended that it had difficulty in using the reporting software, and that it lacked familiarity with some aspects of accounting. The Committee explained that it corrected the reporting problem by hiring a professional familiar with filing FEC reports.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **Assign ADR 388/RAD 07L-13 to the ADR Office.**
