Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Work with RAD to terminate the Committee and pay a civil
penalty of \$1,000 (\$74,423 in dispute)

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to
ADR 411 (RAD 07L-28). This case was received on August 14, 2007, and was assigned to
the ADR Office on August 24, 2007.

SUMMARY: RAD referred Citizens for Sherman Parker and Joshua T. Campbell,
Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial
activity on their 2006 July Quarterly Report. Respondents filed their original 2006
July Quarterly Report on July 18, 2006. The Committee filed amended 2006 July
Quarterly Reports on November 1, 2006 and November 2, 2006 that disclosed an
aggregate of \$74,423.30 in additional disbursements. In a miscellaneous electronic
message filed on April 18, 2007, Respondents informed RAD that due to the
serious illness of the candidate's mother in June 2006, and her subsequent death in
September 2006, the candidate failed to provide details of expenditures to the
Treasurer in a timely manner.
