Summary and Analysis of Case: Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all receipts. 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a), 434(b)(2), 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a). In this case, Respondents (or “the Committee”) failed to disclose \$87,455.17 in additional receipts on its 2006 30 Day Post-General Report (a 26.9% increase from the original report). The Committee filed the original 2006 30 Day Post-General Report on December 7, 2006, and filed five amended reports.²

In an electronic submission to RAD on March 24, 2007, the Committee explained that the increased receipts resulted from an internal miscommunication relating to transmitted electronic files of contributions received through Emily’s list.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **Assign ADR 415/RAD 07L-32 to the ADR Office.**
