Summary and Analysis of Case:

Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all disbursements, pursuant to the FECA. RAD referred The Hawkeye PAC and Gina Noll, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2006 October Quarterly Report. After timely filing its 2006 October Quarterly Report, the Committee filed an amended 2006 October Quarterly Report on January 30, 2007 that disclosed additional disbursements totaling \$64,940.17.

The Committee provided no response to the RFAI sent to it on March 14, 2007 regarding the additional disbursements.

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. Assign ADR 416 /RAD 07L-33 to the ADR Office.**
