RESOLUTION TERMS: Certifications of 2006 and 2007 Audit Results to the Commission; draft and submit a statement of internal controls; and civil penalty of \$2,000 (amount in dispute \$81,374.02)

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 417 (RAD 07L-34). This case was received by the ADR Office on September 17, 2007, and was assigned to the ADR Office on September 28, 2007.

SUMMARY: Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all receipts. 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a), 434(b)(2), 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a). In this case, Respondents (or "the Committee") failed to disclose \$81,374.02 in additional receipts on its 2006 12 Day Pre-General Report. The Committee filed the original 2006 12 Day Pre-General Report on October 26, 2006, and filed the amended report disclosing the additional receipts on March 20, 2007. In response to Commission inquiries, the Committee explained that it had failed to include bank interest and had difficulties uploading data into the e-filing system, which resulted in the failure to report payroll deduction contributions.
