Summary and Analysis of Case: Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all receipts and disbursements, pursuant to the FECA. RAD referred the Miller Alfano Raspanti PAC and Gaetan Alfano (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2005 Mid-Year Report. An amended 2005 Mid-Year Report, filed April 16, 2006, disclosed \$55,650.12 in additional receipts, and \$58,068.00 in additional disbursements.

In response to a RFAI sent to the Committee on March 2, 2007, the Committee filed a miscellaneous text message stating that in order to meet the deadline to file the 2005 Mid-Year Report, the report was filed without complete information. The Committee then amended the report to disclose the correct information.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **Assign ADR 418/RAD 07L-35 to the ADR Office.**
