RESOLUTION TERMS: Work with Commission staff to terminate the committee and pay a civil penalty of \$2,000 (amount in dispute \$55,650.12 in additional receipts and \$58,068 in additional disbursements)

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 418 (RAD 07L-35). This case was received on September 18, 2007, and was assigned to the ADR Office on October 1, 2007.

SUMMARY: RAD referred Respondents or the Committee for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2005 Mid-Year Report. An amended 2005 Mid-Year Report, filed April 16, 2006, disclosed \$55,650.12 in additional receipts, and \$58,068.00 in additional disbursements. On March 2, 2007, the Committee filed a miscellaneous text message stating that in order to meet the deadline to file the 2005 Mid-Year Report, the report was filed without complete information. The Committee then amended the report to disclose the correct information.
