Summary and Analysis of Case: Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity, including all receipts. 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a), 434(b)(2), 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a). In this case, Respondents (or "the Committee") failed to disclose \$70,600 in additional receipts on its 2006 October Quarterly Report (a 21% increase in activity). The Committee filed the original 2006 October Quarterly on October 16, 2006 and the amended report disclosing the additional receipts on May 18, 2007. In an electronic submission, the Committee explained that it used a specialist to review its FEC reports and filed amended reports based on this review.

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. Assign ADR 423/RAD 07L-42 to the ADR Office.**
