SUBJECT: ADR 425 Connecticut Republicans and Gerald Labriola, Jr. Treasurer,
Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Appoint a compliance specialist, develop and maintain a
compliance manual for staff use, and pay a civil penalty of
\$1,800 (amount in dispute \$295,740)

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to
ADR 425 (RR 07L-40). This case was received on October 25, 2007, and was assigned to
the ADR Office on November 6, 2007.

SUMMARY: RAD referred the Connecticut Republicans and Gerald Labriola, Jr.,
Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial
activity on their 2006 October Monthly Report. The Committee filed its original
2006 October Monthly Report on October 20, 2006. An amended 2006 October
Monthly Report filed on March 2, 2007 disclosed \$295,740 in additional receipts.
In response to the inquiry from RAD, Respondents stated that they filed an
amended 2006 October Monthly Report when they realized the original 2006
October Monthly Report did not include items received in September, but deposited
in October. The contributions had incorrectly been disclosed on the 12 Day Pre-

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General Report, rather than on the earlier 2006 October Monthly Report, based on the date of deposit rather than the date of receipt.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached settlement agreement of Connecticut Republicans and Gerald Labriola, Jr., Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
