**Summary and Analysis of Case:** Treasurers of political committees are required to report all financial activity. The Reports Analysis Division referred Republicans for Choice and Ann E.W. Stone, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for a series of errors during the 2005-2006 election cycle. While many of the errors involved mathematical discrepancies, Respondents' reports also included the late filing of a report, a failure to provide supporting schedules, and a failure to clarify public communication expenses.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

- 1. Assign ADR 438/RAD 07L-57 to the ADR Office.**
